The Train Must Stop At Clunes

The public meeting held at the Clunes Town Hall on Wednesday, 7th October attracted a standing room crowd of 130 people, keen to discuss the obvious need to have the restored Ballarat to Maryborough passenger train service stop at Clunes.

The Mayor of the Shire of Hepburn, Bill McClenaghan and Councillor Don Henderson were warmly welcomed and gave speeches of support from the areas they represent on Council.

Three motions were passed unanimously calling for the train to stop at Clunes and pro forma letters were signed, which were subsequently mailed to the Member for Ripon, Joe Helper, the Minister for Public Transport, Lynne Kosky, and the Premier, John Brumby.

From this meeting a Committee was formed of people who had offered to be involved in working together to stress the case for the train to stop at Clunes. The new

Committee met on Monday, 19th October and has named itself "The Committee for a Train Service at Clunes".

A number of decisions were made, with the main aim of seeking to have the train stop at Clunes as part of the passenger train re-introduction plan.

The first public activity will be a publicity photo of as many people as possible at the Clunes Railway Station at 2pm on Clunes Showday (21st November) waving their hands from the platform to show "they want the train to stop". Press coverage has been arranged to photograph the event. The Committee encourages all train supporters to show up.

Starting November 9th, 2009 there are significant changes to the Road Safety Act, in regards to the wearing of seat belts and in particular the use of child restraints, use of mobile phones and new rules in regards to line markings. All of the new rules are further explained on the Vic Roads website (www.vicroads.vic.gov.au/roadrules). There will be explanatory brochures in the Mini Police Station at the post office to help explain the new rules. If you have any questions give me a call.

Hepburn L2P Needs Volunteers

Australia's 'P plate' drivers have the highest road toll of all driver categories, so VicRoads has introduced a scheme where learners log 120 hours of driving time to progress to their 'P plates'. This scheme has reduced the road toll of young drivers in Europe by 30%.

L2P is a program of 7 free driving lessons with a qualified instructor and 120 hours of free supervised driving time with a volunteer. Hepburn Shire Council in partnership with Daylesford Neighbourhood Center and Hepburn Health Service is seeking local organisations and individuals to volunteer time as a supervising driver. No previous experience is necessary as training and support are provided. 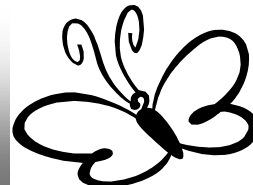

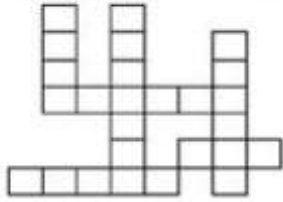

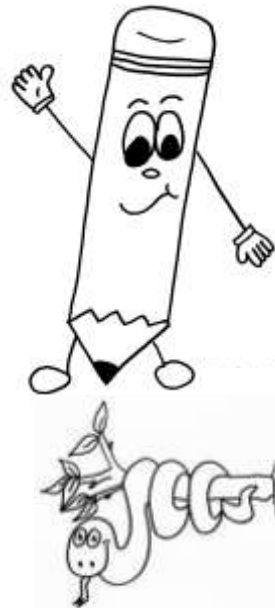
