Clunes Economic Development Forum

Over 40 people attended this Forum on 25 March 2010, which was initiated by the Clunes Community Planning Group in response to the Clunes Community Plan priority - Support local industries.

Speakers Jim Robinson, Councillor Tim Hayes, and Neil Newitt (President of Clunes Tourism Development Association) welcomed participants and spoke about:

- the need to preserve the heritage values of the town while providing attractive options to new business ventures;
- progress on preparation of an economic development strategic plan;
- the need to continue to engage the Clunes community;
- development of 'products' that will attract visitors and investors, and complement the current attractions;
- building on the literature theme to maintain a 'cultural destination centred around literature'.

Panel speakers included John Collins, Economic Development and Tourism Manager, Hepburn Shire Council, discussed the Buy Local campaign which is about to be rolled out, and Tim Wills from Regional Development Victoria (RDV) provided information about the assistance available to small business through RDV.

Graeme Johnston from Creative Clunes spoke about the success they have had with Booktown and highlighted a number of opportunities including:

- Clunes Caravan Park
- Farmers Market – linked to Buy Local campaign
- Retail training
- The role Creative Clunes can play in auspicing events and activities.

Justin Fiddes, Planning Manager, Hepburn Shire Council spoke about the current Structure Plan for Clunes, the forthcoming review of the Municipal Strategic Statement and encouraged the Clunes community to take the opportunity to get involved in the review consultations.

Clunes Villages Video

You may have noticed some filming taking place in Clunes recently. Tourism Victoria is making a video about Clunes to showcase its unique charms. Clunes and Daylesford are the only towns in the Hepburn Shire to be selected. Videos have already been made for some iconic destinations such as the Great Ocean Road and Port Fairy so it is terrific that Clunes has been recognised as something special.

The video is not just about tourism, it is showcasing the town and will be a valuable tool to promote Clunes. It will help promote the town to anyone who is looking for information about Clunes, be they visitors, potential residents, businesses etc.

The CTDA along with Creative Clunes, Hepburn Shire and other local businesses will be contributing to the cost of producing the video. G'day everyone, it's that time again; firstly the Crime round up.... It's been a busy month in the Clunes area since the last newsletter. There have been several burglaries committed in the area, both on residential houses and business premises. A 24 year old male has been charged with these offences and at the time of writing this article, was being held on remand in at the Ballarat Police Cells. The burglaries were opportunistic in that the offender has entered houses that were vacant, either because they are holiday homes or the occupants were away for extended periods of time. I would ask locals if you live next door to a vacant house (ie holiday house or occupants away on holidays) please keep an eye out and report any suspicious behaviour to police ASAP. Once again there is absence from residence forms at the post office for anyone who is going away on holidays to fill out and send off to me.

Operation AEGIS VII conducted over Easter was a

great success in that there were no recorded fatalities in the area and as a positive I conducted just over 500 random preliminary breath tests in the area over the 6 days and not one recorded .05, so a great response to the road safety message by you all and I thank you very much for that. I hope everyone had a great Easter break.

Good to see the footy and netball teams off to a flying start for the season ahead and for those who did not see last months newsletter, I have organised with the coaches of the junior teams, both netball and footy, to provide a trophy from the Clunes Police to the player judged the best team person for the year. The award will be called the Clunes Police Leadership award and I wish all the kids the very best of luck. The award has nothing to do with the best player as that prize already exists, this trophy will be awarded to the player with the best and most consistent behaviour, attitude and sportsmanship throughout the year both on and off the field/court.

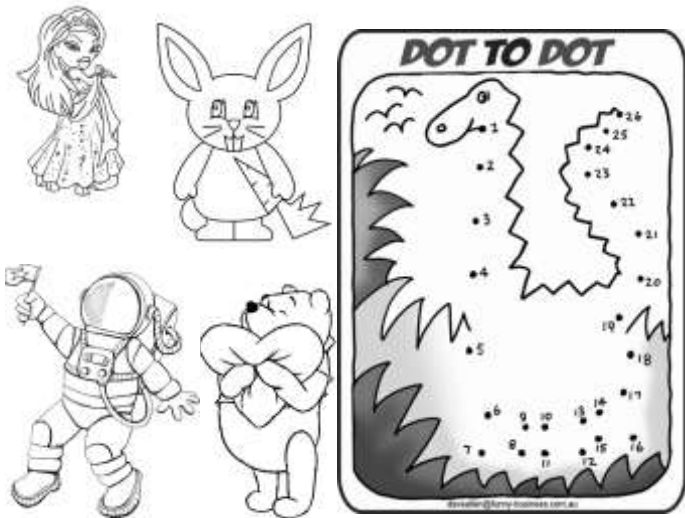
